BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I. That whereas, it is the opinion of the Town

Council of the Town of Kirkland that it is for the best interest

of the Town of Kirkland to dispose of that portion of the Town

Park, for the sum of \$ 9000 = ... described as follows, to-wit:

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to the Union A. High School District No. 71, King County, Wash.

SECTION 2: That in order to dispose of said property, as above set forth, it will be necessary to call a special election in the Town of Kirkland, now, therefore, be it resolved by the said council to request, and they do hereby request the election board of King County, Washington to call a special election in the Town of Kirkland to vote on the question of selling said park property to Union A. High School District No. 71, King County, Washington for the sum of \$ 8000 = as above set forth.
