RESOLUTION NO. 169

DE IT RESOLVED BY THE YOUN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Town Council to order the improvement of Tenth Avenue, from Second Street to Fifth Street; Fifth Street, from Tenth Avenue to Thirteenth Avenue; and Thirteenth Avenue, from Fifth Street to Sixth Street, by renewing the wooden service water main now in place and extending along the avenues and streets above named and replacing the same with new four-inch wooden pipe, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, in accordance with the plans and specifications of the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2. That -11 persons desiring to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections in writing at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chembers of the Town of Kirkland at eight o'clock p. m. on the _____ day of November, 1932, which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement and all objections thereto and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 3. That the engineer in the employ of the Town of Firkland shall, in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

Section 4. That the costs and expenses of said improvement shall be borne and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
