RESOLUTION NO. 17/

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND.

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Town Council to order the improvement of Central Way from Second Street to Lake Street, and lake Street from Central May to the city limits of said town, by replacing the wooden service water-main now in place, and extending along said streets with a new eight-inch iron water-main, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, in accordance with the plans and specifications of the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2. That all persons desiring to object therete are hereby notified to appear and present such objections, in writing, at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chambers of the form of Kirkland, at eight o'clock p. m., on the 2/ day of Movember, 1932, which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement, and all objections therete, and for determining the method of payment for said improvemnt.

Section 3. That the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland shall, in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

Section 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne and assessed in the following prepartion, to-wit: 50 per cent thereof shall be assessed to the property abutting the line of said improvement which is specially benefitted thereby, and 50 per cent thereof by the said from of Lirkland.
