RESOLUTION # 173

Be it resolved by the Town Council of Kirkland Washington

Section 1 That whereas an emergency exists it is the opinion of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland that the issuing and selling of Bonds to the amount of \$12,000.00 to build a Town Hall is advisable. We do hereby request the Election Board of King County, Washington to call a special election to be held August 29, 1933 at Kirkland, Washington.

Section 2 That there shall be placed on the ballot at said special election the proposition to be voted on in words and figures substantially as follows, to-wit :

Shall the Town of Kirkland issue \$12,000.00 in Bonds to build a Town Hall .
