

RESOLUTION NO. 175.

WHEREAS, because of the heavy travel at the intersection of Lake and Kirkland Avenues in the Town of Kirkland, it is deemed necessary for the convenience, safety and protection of the public that a "stop and go" traffic signal should be installed and maintained at said point; and,

Whereas, King County, by its proper officers, has offered to furnish the material for and properly install such signal at that point, without cost or expense to the Town, provided said Town will agree to keep said County free from any and all liability for damages which may arise or accrue by reason thereof;

IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND,

That if King County shall furnish the material for and install a TRAFFIC SIGNAL at the place and in the manner specified in the foregoing preamble, in consideration thereof, the said Town of Kirkland will save and keep harmless the said King County from any and all liability for damages which it may at any time incur or become liable for by reason thereof.
