## RESOLUTION NO. 178

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 111 of the Laws of the State of Washington, 1935, certain monies will be available to the Town of Kirkland from a fund in the state treasury, known as the "motor vehicle fund" for the maintenance of main traveled streets through such Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Highways, acting under the authority of said law, has required that said Town designate such main traveled streets of said Town which are to be maintained from funds accruing under such law;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, that the following streets be and they are hereby designated as main traveled streets of said Town which are to be maintained from funds accruing under said law, to wit:

- (a) Market street from the northerly limits of said Town southerly to Central Way;
  - (b) Central Way from Market street to Lake st.
- (4) Bake st. from Central Way to the southerly limits of said Town.
