Resolution No. 185

Whereas, the Laws of 1935 provide that the State Motor Vehicle Fund shall contribute to the Town of Kirkland for Street maintenance purposes each year \$1.50 per capita according to last census,

and Whereas, the State Highway Department will be delayed several months in its payments of \$211.04 per month into the fund to be known as the Secondary Highway Fund, but nevertheless it is desirable that the work should be done and continued upon the Highways, Particularly in view of present unemployment, and

Whereas, there is in the Cemetery fund of the Town sufficient money which is not required to be used at present, to make a loan for this purpose to the said Highway Fund,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland that the Town Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to make a temporary transfer as a loan from the Cemetery Fund to the fund known as the Secondary Highway Fund, ~~in the amount of \$~~ \$500.00 this same to be repaid to the Cemetery Fund when and as the Motor Vehicle Fund of the State repays the Town for its advances and expenditures of the same.
