

WHEREAS, School District No. 71 of King County, Washington has in contemplation the construction of a new school house upon the grounds now occupied by the present school house of said District which embrace all of ^{Block} ~~Lot~~ No. 206 of the Map of Kirkland; and,

WHEREAS, in the construction of such new school house it will be necessary to use a portion of Fourth Avenue lying east of First street as a location for a septic tank; and the use thereof for such purposes will not in any way interfere with the use of said Fourth Avenue for street purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, that said School District No. 71 of King County, Washington, be, and it is hereby authorized and empowered to use so much of Fourth Avenue of said Town, lying east of First street as may be necessary for the installation and maintenance of a septic tank to be used in connection with the school house and buildings of said District; provided, however, that such tank shall be installed and maintained in such a manner as not to interfere with the use of said Fourth Avenue for street purposes.
