

RESOLUTION NO 205

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND,
that that certain plat, known as the Columbia Lumber Company Addi-
tion to the City of Kirkland, which plat embraces the following
described tract of land in the City of Kirkland, County of King,
State of Washington, described as follows:

That part of Government Lots 4 and 5, in Section 6, Township
25 North, Range 5 East, W.M. and shore lands of the second class
fronting thereon, described as follows:-

Beginning on the westerly line of Lake Avenue (now vacated)
as shown on the Map of Kirkland at a point which is South $61^{\circ}30'$
West, 80 feet, and North $28^{\circ}30'$ West, 600 feet from the most
southerly corner of Lot 20, Block 3, of said Map; thence South
 $61^{\circ}30'$ West, 137.00 feet to the true place of beginning of this
description, being a point on the northeasterly boundary of that
vacated portion of Lake Avenue West in the City of Kirkland vacated
by the City Council of said City by Ordinance dated December 20th,
1937, and approved by the Mayor December 20th, 1937; thence from
said true point of beginning South $61^{\circ}30'00''$ West, 386.82 feet to
the Inner Harbor Line of Lake Washington; thence along the said
Inner Harbor Line South $15^{\circ}32'32''$ East, 421.053 feet and South 37°
 $27'32''$ East, 192.015 feet to a point which bears South $61^{\circ}30'00''$
West from the most southerly corner of said Lot 20; thence North
 $61^{\circ}30'00''$ East, 458.643 feet to the northeasterly boundary of the
described vacated portion of Lake Avenue West; thence along the
said northeasterly boundary North $29^{\circ}36'12''$ West, 379.458 feet and
North $28^{\circ}30'00''$ West, 220.61 feet to the true place of beginning.
