

RESOLUTION NO. 206.

*Repealed by 2063*

WHEREAS, there are at present six (6) establishments, within the City limits of the City of Kirkland, where beer and wine may be purchased by the glass for consumption on the premises, in addition to many places where such commodities may be purchased for consumption off of the premises, and whereas, an over-abundance of drinking places is not for the best interest of civic welfare:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland that no approval be given for the establishment of any new or additional tavern, beer or wine parlor, or place where beer and/or wine may be purchased by the glass for consumption on the premises, and that said City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby requests the Washington State Liquor Control Board not to issue any new or additional licenses for such places in the City of Kirkland, unless this resolution be amended or repealed.

BE it further resolved that if any of the present six (6) beer parlors cease to be a going concern for any reason whatsoever, that no new license be issued, until the number is reduced to four (4).
