

RESOLUTION NO. 109-1/2 *How*

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Clerk of the City of Kirkland, a petition for the vacation of certain street property in the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, said property petitioned to be vacated is duly described in the petition filed with the clerk on the 5th day of October, 1928, and it appearing that said petition is signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting upon the part of said street sought to be vacated,
