

RESOLUTION NO 210

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

Whereas, it is the intention of the City Council to improve various streets in the City of Kirkland by clearing, grubbing, grading, sloping, draining, gravel surfacing and curb and gutter construction, together with all other work incidental thereto under WORKS PROGRESS ADMINISTRATION NO. 2500,

BE IT RESOLVED, that said improvement shall be done by the day labor method under the provisions of Chapter 187 of the Session Laws of 1937, and that the same be designated as City Street Fund Project No. .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said project shall be city wide and shall pertain to all streets requiring improving in the City of Kirkland.
