

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways has estimated that the receipts which will accrue to the credit of this City under the provisions of Chapter 181, 1939 Laws, for the period April 1, 1939, to March 31, 1941, will be _____ (\$ 7096.50) Dollars:

and

WHEREAS, there is an unexpended balance of funds which accrued to the credit of this City during the period April 1st, 1937 to March 31st, 1939 of _____ (\$ 187.50); and

WHEREAS, the total funds available for expenditure during the period April 1st, 1939 to March 31st, 1941 is therefore estimated to be _____ (\$ 7284.50); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways does request that this City adopt a formal program setting forth the uses to which it shall put the above-named sum of money in accordance with the provisions of the above-named statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Kirkland in regular meeting duly assembled, as follows:

1. That based upon estimated receipts as aforesaid the following is proposed as the items covering expenditures of said City from the City Street Fund for the biennium commencing April 1, 1939, and ending March 31, 1941:
