WHEREAS, the ~~Town~~ <sup>City</sup> Council of the ~~Town~~ <sup>City</sup> of Kirkland

on April 1, 1940 passed a resolution setting up funds available for the period April 1, 1939 to March 31, 1941, under the items of Maintenance, Construction and Overhead, and,

WHEREAS, it is found necessary to revise the setup under the above mentioned items;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the ~~(Mayor and Town Council)~~ <sup>(Mayor and City Council or Commission)</sup> of the ~~(town)~~ <sup>(city)</sup> of Kirkland in regular meeting duly assembled, as follows:

1. That based upon estimated receipts as aforesaid the following is proposed as the items covering expenditures of said ~~(town)~~ <sup>(city)</sup> from the City Street Fund for the biennium commencing April 1, 1939, and ending

3. That the ~~(town)~~ <sup>(city)</sup> clerk be, and is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of this ~~(Ordinance)~~ <sup>(Resolution)</sup> to the Department of Highways.
