

R E S O L U T I O NNo. 275

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is constructing a complete sewerage service system; and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City has passed an ordinance fixing the rates for sewerage service and has provided therein that the Council may fix rates for such service by resolution for all classes of buildings, structures and properties not provided for in said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to fix rates for sewerage service for the schools, gasoline stations, beer parlors and taverns, and a hospital, all within the limits of the City of Kirkland,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following rates and charges are hereby fixed for sewerage service for the following described classes of buildings, structures and properties, to wit:

All High school buildings,	13 per month
All Junior High School buildings and	3 " "
Grade school buildings,	3 " "
All gasoline and service stations	5.50 per month
All beer parlors and taverns	5.50 " "
All hospitals	5.50 " "

Provided, that if any of the above pay their monthly service charges on or before the 15th day of the month, the following amounts shall be deducted from said monthly rates:

High schools	.125
Junior high schools and grade schools	.65
Gasoline and service stations	.50
Beer parlors and taverns	.50
Hospitals	.50
