WHEREAS, the <sup>(City)</sup>~~(Town)~~ Council of the <sup>(City)</sup>~~(Town)~~ of Kirkland on June 16-1941 passed a resolution setting up funds available for the period April 1, 1941, to March 31, 1943, under the items of Maintenance, Construction and Overhead, and,

WHEREAS, It is found necessary to revise the setup under the above mentioned items;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the <sup>(Mayor and City Council or Commission)</sup>~~(Mayor and Town Council)~~ of the <sup>(City)</sup>~~(Town)~~ of Kirkland in regular meeting duly assembled as follows:

1. That based upon estimated receipts as aforesaid the following is proposed as the items covering expenditures of said <sup>(City)</sup>~~(Town)~~ from the City Street Fund for the biennium commencing April 1, 1941, and ending March 31, 1943:
