

RESOLUTION No 281 A

WHEREAS,

It is deemed necessary to alter the Traffic Control installation at the intersection of S. S. H. 2A and S. S. H 2B, from a stop then go flasher signal to a Manual Controlled stop and go signal in order to expedite the movement of traffic during the peak hours.

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

That three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00) be set aside from the gasoline tax money accruing to the City of Kirkland, for the cost of a Traffic Count and installation of said signal.
