

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND,
WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to improve 1st Avenue
located in the City of Kirkland between Lake Street and 1st
Street, and

WHEREAS, an asphalt surfacing on this street is necessary
for the health and safety of the public, and

WHEREAS, heretofore bids have been called on this proposed
improvement and only one bid was received, the same having been
submitted by the Washington Asphalt Co.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this work be performed
in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Engineer,
at an estimated cost of \$3715.00 plus the Washington State Sales
Tax and Engineering costs; that the bid of the Washington Asphalt
Company, in the sum of \$3715.00 plus sales tax, be accepted; that
of this sum, the sum of \$1402.80 be derived from contributions of
property owners holding property adjacent to said improvement and
the balance to be drawn from the fund now credited or to be
credited to the City of Kirkland in the Motor Vehicle Fund.
