

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 288

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
KIRKLAND:

That whereas it appears to be to the advantage of the  
City of Kirkland that said City grant to the United States of  
America, represented by the Federal Works Administrator,  
Washington, D. C., an easement to construct a water system,  
with necessary appurtenances thereto, through, on, and over  
the following-described property of the City of Kirkland:

The East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW  $\frac{1}{4}$   
of SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section Seventeen (17), Township  
Twenty-five (25) North, Range Five (5) E.W.M.,

and co-extensive therewith a license, privilege and right to use  
and divert water from said property to the amount of four-tenths  
(.4) of one cubic foot per second;

That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized as duly  
qualified officers of the City of Kirkland to execute the above-  
described easement, for and on behalf of said City.
