RESOLUTION No. 394

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, there exists an emergency in that expenses have arisen in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Kirkland Sewer System which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time the 1943 budget was adopted, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland has passed and approved an ordinance establishing said emergency and providing for the issuance of emergency warrants to procure funds for said emergency, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has certain surpluses heretofore created in its Water Fund, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESCLVED that the Water Fund of the City of Kirkland shall lend to the Sewer Fund of the City of Kirkland, from time to time as need srises, a sum or sums, the total of which shall not exceed SHM. Dollars at 1 interest per annum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the preparation of the 1944 budget, provision shall be made for the repayment of funds so lent in the year 1943.
