

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is engaged in a certain  
street-improvement project, and

WHEREAS, said street improvements are made necessary and  
mandatory by the existing unserviceable conditions of the streets  
in said City, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Works Agency, an agency of the United  
States of America, has heretofore granted funds in the sum of  
Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) to be used in connection  
with certain street improvements, and

WHEREAS, said grant was made in connection with the Kirkland  
Sewer Project, and

WHEREAS, said street work was made necessary by virtue of  
said Sewer Project, and

WHEREAS, some funds in excess of the sum of Fourteen Thousand  
Dollars (\$14,000.00) will be necessary to complete the program as  
presently projected, and

WHEREAS, it appears that such additional funds will be in the  
approximate sum of \$2,300.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF KIRKLAND That the expenditure of funds in the sum of  
\$2,300.00 existing in the street fund of and for the City of  
Kirkland be hereby authorized.
