

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 303

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, there exists in the City of Kirkland and the territory immediately adjacent thereto a traffic emergency in that the main traffic arteries in said area are insufficient to efficiently and adequately accommodate the daily necessary vehicular traffic in connection with the defense workers going to and from the Lake Washington Shipyards, the Ballinger Boat Works, the Boeing Aircraft Corporation and other defense industries located in this area, and

WHEREAS, this traffic congestion has been the cause of numerous traffic accidents and personal injuries, and has caused a great and uneconomical loss of time and motor fuel for those who daily traverse these routes, and

WHEREAS, said conditions have caused some defense workers to forsake their employment, and

WHEREAS, these conditions can be relieved by widening and improving the main traffic arteries leading to and through the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest and welfare of the defense program that alleviating measures be taken immediately,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL IN AND FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RESOLVES to aid, assist, and cooperate in every manner possible to secure, at the earliest possible time, adequate roadway improvements and facilities.
