## RESOLUTION

No. 307

BE IT RESCLIVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLICWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has heretofore issued Sewer Revenue Bonds in the sum of One Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00), and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland received from the sale of said bonds the sum of One Hundred Five Thousand Two Hundred Forty Mine Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$105,249.13), and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said bond issue and sale was to supply a portion of the funds necessary for the construction of the Kirk-land Sewer System, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has heretofore authorized the deposit of the sum of one Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) from the proceeds from the sale of said bonds in the Sewer Construction Fund, and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed to complete the construction of said sewer system, and

WHEREAS, all funds raised from the sale of said bonds were heretofore pledged to the purpose of constructing said sewer system,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Treasurer of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to deposit the sum of Five Thousand Two Hundred Forty Nine Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$5,249.13), representing the balance of said revenues produced from the sale of said bonds, in the sewer construction fund.
