R E S O L U T I O N

No. 310

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the municipal streets in and about the City of Kirkland are in a greatly depreciated condition and are in need of immediate attention and construction work in order to make them serviceable, and

WHEREAS, the current labor situation is such that it is impossible to secure competent trained workmen to perform the necessary work and particularly to operate the street-repair and construction equipment, and

WHEREAS, CHESTER WICK, a member of the City Council of the City of Kirkland, is an experienced and competent workman to perform such work, and

WHEREAS, he is willing to assist the City in this present emergency by contributing his experience and time by operating some of the street construction and repair equipment for the City of Kirkland,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR of the City of Kirkland is directed to employ said Chester Wick at such time as his services may be available to assist in street repairs and construction in and for the City of Kirkland, and to pay to the said Chester Wick the prevailing hourly wage for such services.
