R E S O L U T I O N
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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, on the 11th day of June, 1943, a motion was duly made and passed at the regularly called Council Meeting of the Council of the City of Kirkland that a contract be made between the City of Kirkland and C. V. Wilder Company for the construction of the sewer line on the premises of the Lake Washington Shipyards Company, a corporation, at Houghton, Washington, from Pumphouse No. 2 to the manhole located in the northeast Lake Washington Boulevard in front of said premises on the easterly side thereof, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said motion was made in order that such a contract could be drawn and the work contemplated be performed under Force Account provisions of the Federal Works Agency, an agency of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Federal Works Agency requests and desires a City resolution concerning this matter,

NOW, THEREFORE, said Motion is hereby confirmed by this Resolution, whereby the C. V. Wilder Company is directed to proceed with the construction and laying of an eight inch (8") sewer pipe to a depth of approximately three feet (3') for a distance of approximately six hundred fifty feet (650') on the premises of the Lake Washington Shipyards Company by and between Pumphouse No. 2 and the manhole located in the northeast Lake Washington Boulevard east of said Company's premises, and said contractor is to properly backfill said excavated portions and replace the oil paving when said backfill has been completed.

The contractor shall be paid for this work at the rate of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per lineal foot for excavations and backfill and in addition thereto shall be reimbursed for the cost of pipe and fitting and shall be paid in addition his costs plus fifteen percent (15%) for the removal of sheet metal, concrete, logs or timbers encountered in the excavation work.

It is directed that this work be performed in accordance with the Force Account provisions of the Federal Works Agency, and that application for said Force Account work be immediately made to said Agency.
