

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 315

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, The City of Kirkland has heretofore submitted to the Federal Works Agency an application for a Kirkland paving project, and

WHEREAS, It appears that the project in the form submitted to the Federal Works Agency is not acceptable to that agency, and it further appears that the said Federal Works Agency is willing to consider recommendations for a portion of that project pursuant to a letter of H. E. Sisler, Engineer for the City of Kirkland, submitted to the Federal Works Agency on July 16, 1943,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DOES BY THIS RESOLUTION approve said recommendations contained in said letter of July 16, 1943, and herewith directs Harry M. Everett, as Mayor in and for the City of Kirkland, to negotiate with the Federal Works Agency for the program recommended in said letter, and herewith authorizes said Harry M. Everett to execute for and on behalf of the City of Kirkland such papers as may be necessary to secure the acceptance by the Federal Works Agency of said partial project, which is hereby designated as the Kirkland Paving Project No. 45-271.
