

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 319

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the establishment of a sewer system in and for the City of Kirkland has caused great damage to the City streets in said City, and this damage has necessitated a very expensive road-repair program at a total cost of \$ 25,822⁰⁰, in order to resurface and restore the condition of said City streets, and

WHEREAS, The Federal Works Agency has heretofore granted to the City of Kirkland the sum of \$ 14,000.⁰⁰ for the purpose of this street-repair work, and it now appears that said sum is insufficient to cover the cost thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City of Kirkland does hereby make application to the Federal Works Agency for an additional allotment of funds in the sum of \$ 11,822⁰⁰ from the funds available to Project Wash. 45-151, for the purpose of covering said deficiency in funds for the payment of said street-repair work.
