BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:


THAT WHEREAS, It appears in the best interest of the City of Kirkland that certain plans now be formulated and established for the guidance of the City of Kirkland in creating post-war employment,

NOW, THEREFORE, Mayor Harry M. Everett, Engineer Harry E. Sisler, and City Attorney L. N. Ostrander are hereby appointed as the post-war planning committee for the City of Kirkland, and said committee is hereby directed to immediately commence research and study with reference to feasible public improvement work such as sidewalks and curbing, storm sewers, new city hall, and other municipal buildings, extensions to water works and sewer system and public park and playground improvements, which may be undertaken when the War has terminated. Said committee is further directed to, from time to time, report to the City Council upon the progress of its undertaking and to reduce its findings to writing.
