

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 321

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS  
FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, The City Sewer System in and for the City of  
Kirkland is incomplete in that the sewer disposal plant has not been  
equipped with machinery for the removal of sludge and scum, and

WHEREAS, The lack of said removal machinery causes said disposal  
plant to be very expensive to operate and reduces the efficiency of  
said plant, and

WHEREAS, This defect may be overcome with a relatively small  
expenditure of money,

NOW, THEREFORE, H. M. Sisler, Engineer for said Project, and  
L. N. Ostrander, as City attorney, are hereby directed to take such  
steps as may be necessary to secure from the Federal Works Agency a  
change order in Project Wash. 45-151, and the grant of such additional  
funds as may be needed for the development and construction of said  
removal equipment.
