RESOLUTION

No. 329 A

BE IT RESCLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRELAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT UNDREAD, the population of the City of Mirkland and the area immediately adjacent thereto has very nearly doubled during the past four years, and

WHEREAS, the gasoline and tire chortage at the present time makes it difficult for residents on this side of Lake Washington to drive to and from Seattle by the longer route around Lake Washington, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Washington Forry Company has not measurably added to its cervice to this community during the past four (4) years, and

WHENEAS, the interests of this community and the velfare of its population require that more frequent ferry service be made available to Mirkland and this area.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE DO RESOLVE That additional forry sorvice between the City of Kirkland and the Madicon Street Forry Dock is needed immediately, in particular, forry service of greater frequency than is now available.

Ve do further resolve that the City of Kirkland take every practicable step to secure the cooperation of the management of the Lake Vashington Ferry to voluntarily adding such additional ferry sorvice, or to force said cooperation through the Department of Public Service of the State of Vashington and through the Office of the King County Commissioners.
