

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Bureau of Community Facilities of the Federal Works Agency, in behalf of the City of Kirkland, an application for Federal assistance under the so-called Lanham Act as amended; and the United States of America, acting by and through the Commissioner of Community Facilities, has transmitted to the City of Kirkland for acceptance an agreement of Federal assistance in connection with the said project referred to in said application and described in said agreement, and

WHEREAS, said agreement has been duly read in open meeting, fully considered in accordance with all pertinent rules of procedure and legal requirements and made a part of the applicant's public record, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and in the public interest that said agreement be accepted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND That said agreement, a true and correct copy of which including the terms and conditions, is hereto attached, be and the same hereby is accepted without reservation or qualification.
