

R E S O L U T I O N

No. 343

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AS  
FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, there has been filed by the City of Kirkland an application with the Federal Works Agency, an agency of the United States of America, for federal assistance in connection with advanced engineering work for the establishment of street and sidewalk grades and markers in the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, said Federal Works Agency has granted for this purpose the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to the City of Kirkland, and


WHEREAS, of said sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) is immediately available to the City of Kirkland,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor, Harry M. Everett, is hereby authorized to execute, in behalf of the City of Kirkland, a voucher, or such other form as is required by said Federal Works Agency, to secure the immediate payment of said grant of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in connection with said street and sidewalk project designated as Washington 45-P-2.
