

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AS
FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the Federal Works Agency, through its Bureau of Community Facilities, is prepared to enter into an agreement with the City of Kirkland to advance Five Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$5,400.00) to the City of Kirkland, for the purpose of advance planning for the construction of a sewer system comprising interceptor, main and lateral sewers with the necessary appurtenances in the northwest portion of the City of Kirkland and territory immediately adjacent thereto, and

WHEREAS, this grant and this construction project is deemed advantageous to the City of Kirkland,


NOW, THEREFORE, Harry M. Everett, as Mayor of the City of Kirkland, and C. F. Trent, as Clerk of the City of Kirkland, are hereby authorized to execute an agreement and public voucher entered into with the Federal Works Agency, for the immediate and initial payment of fifty per cent (50%) of the said grant of Five Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$5,400.00).
