## RESOLUTION

## No. 352

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland Fire Department possesses inadequate equipment with which to combat fires and to comply with the requirements of the Insurance Rating Bureau, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the general welfare of said city and is emergent that adequate fire-fighting equipment be acquired immediately, and

WHEREAS, there is immediately available to the City of Kirkland one 1945 Buffalo Fire Truck at a net cost to said city of Thirteen Thousand Fifteen Dollars (\$13,015.00), and

WHEREAS, the City does not have in its 1946 Budget sufficient provision for the purchase of this equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, there is appropriated from the General Fund and lent to the Fire Department Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), for the purchase of this equipment, which said sum shall be repaid to the General Fund in the fiscal year 1947, from the Fire Department Fund, to gether with interest thereon at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_\_ per centum per annum.

The Treasurer of the City of Kirkland is hereby instructed to make appropriate entries to complete this loan.
