

RESOLUTION No. 366

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

That the petition of John H. Swanson and Margaret Swanson, his wife, and Edward R. Murray and Hayden Williams and Ruth Williams, his wife, and LeRoy E. Johnson and Nellie Johnson, his wife, to vacate a portion of the alley on the east side of the Eastside Motor Company Garage, which is described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Unplatted Tract "A" in Burke and Farrar's Business Center Addition, Division No. 35, as recorded in volume 35 of plats, page 14, records of King County, Washington; thence North 89-39'-00" East, 98.54 feet to the true point of beginning; thence North 2-21'-00" East, 30.05 feet; thence South 0-21'-00" East, 30.00 feet; thence South 89-39'-00" West, 1.46 feet, to the true point of beginning,

to the said petitioners, having come on for hearing at a regular meeting of the City Council on this date, and it appearing to the City Council that the property conveyed to the City of Kirkland by the said petitioners is of far greater value to the City of Kirkland than the property proposed to be vacated, and that the said proposed vacation of property will serve to straighten the rest of the line of said alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, the said petition shall be heard and determined on the 13th day of December, 1948, at the regular meeting of the City Council of said City of Kirkland to be held upon that date at the City Hall, and a copy of this resolution shall be posted in three (3) public places in said City of Kirkland, and, in addition, a conspicuous place on the alley ^{Proposed} ~~to be~~ to be vacated.
