RESOLUTION NO. 376

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland maintains and operates a complete water distribution system through the territory adjacent to the South of said city, and within the city limits of the City of Houghton, and

WHEREAS, said City of Kirkland has for many years served water to said area, and the said City of Houghton has recently incorporated, and

WHEREAS, there has been some expression of fear less the City of Kirkland should discriminate in its water rights structure against the residents of the City of Houghton, and the city officials of said City of Houghton desire some official assurance that there will be no such discrimination, now, therefore,

IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED to be the policy of the City of Kirkland that water shall be supplied by said City of Kirkland within the city limits of the City of Houghton, under the same terms and conditions as it is supplied to other areas outside the city limits of Kirkland, and without any discrimination whatsoever.
