

## RESOLUTION NO. 378

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS  
FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the said City of Kirkland owns, as a part of its Park System, a certain athletic field operated in connection with the Kirkland Civic Center, and

WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Kirkland has provided lights for said field, in order that night baseball, night football and other night time activities can be carried on on said field, and it is in the interest of the city, as well as of the Chamber of Commerce, that said field be used as much as possible, and

WHEREAS, the said lighting provisions have cost the Chamber of Commerce a continued liability in the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), and in addition thereto, the Student Body of the Lake Washington High School has contributed the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) or more for the acquisition for said lighting facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce desires an agreement with the City of Kirkland pursuant to which said field can be operated for the mutual benefit of said city and of said Chamber of Commerce, in order to facilitate or permit the said Chamber of Commerce to secure rentals from the said lighting facilities for its benefit and the benefit of the Student Body of the Lake Washington High School, in order to reimburse said bodies for the cost of said lighting facilities,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Kirkland Chamber of Commerce, providing that from the 1st day of October, 1947, until the 1st day of October, 1949, the city will not rent the said field for any evening activities without the consent of the said Chamber of Commerce, which consent shall not be withheld, except in case of the Chamber of Commerce having a conflicting use for said field at said time, and providing further that in any rental agreements which are made by the city with the consent of said chamber, the city shall charge not more than its customary rental rate for the field, and the chamber shall be permitted to make an additional charge for the use of said lighting system, and providing further that the chamber shall not

at any time, arrange for the use of said field without the consent  
of the Mayor of the City of Kirkland, which said consent shall not be  
withheld without cause.
