

RESOLUTION NO. 379

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, the Northwest Greyhound Bus Line has pending before the State of Washington Department of Transportation an application to clarify its certificate of public convenience and necessity by an express provision of authority to operate the busses of said company from Seattle over the Lake Washington Bridge through Kirkland, and then to Redmond, and return,

AND WHEREAS, the existence and continuance of the maximum bus service possible between Kirkland and Seattle, and between Kirkland and Redmond is of the utmost importance, and necessity to the residents of Kirkland and the territory immediately adjacent thereto, and should the right of said company to operate said bus service over said established route be denied or impaired, it would result in a grave inconvenience to the residents of said area,

NOW, THEREFORE, the State of Washington Department of Public Service is earnestly requested to grant the application of said Northwest Greyhound Line for the convenience and necessity of Kirkland, and the territory immediately adjacent.
