

RESOLUTION NO. 390-A

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, a bill has been prepared for presentation to the Washington State Legislature entitled: "An Act Relating to loans to municipalities; establishing a fund; defining crimes and fixing penalties in connection therewith; making an appropriation and declaring an emergency."

AND WHEREAS, said Act would make money available to the cities and towns of Washington upon proper application for capital construction for improvement of water supply systems, drainage systems, and sewage disposal systems; and such funds might be of benefit to the City of Kirkland, now, therefore,

IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED:

(1) The City Council of Kirkland hereby favors and recommends the adoption of the said Act Relating to Loans to Municipalities, etc., by the Legislature of the State of Washington.

(2) The City Council requests and directs that this Resolution be conveyed by the Mayor to appropriate committees and organizations.
