RESOLUTION NO. 392

A RESOLUTION of the Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington, employing counsel for certain services in connection with Local Improvement District No. 94 of the city and the issuance of bonds of said district.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Airkland, Washington, is contemplating the grading and graveling of certain streets and the installing of certain sidewalks and curbings within the city, the creation of a local improvement district, to be numbered 94, for said improvements, the levying of assessments against the property within said district to pay the cost of such improvements, and the issuance of bonds of said district, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interests of the city that bond counsel experienced in such matters be employed to draw the ordinances, resolutions, notices and other documents necessary for the creation of such district, the ordering of such improvements, the levying and collection of such assessments, except the preparation of the necessary assessment roll, the issuance of said bonds, and to give their opinion as to the validity of said bonds at the time of their sale or delivery,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington, as follows:

That Preston, Thorgrimson & Horowitz, attorneys at law of Seattle, Washington, be and they are hereby employed to perform the services above set forth and as compensation therefor the city agrees to pay them the sum of \$250 for drawing all of the above mentioned proceedings and an additional sum of \$300 to \$350 for their said opinion, the exact amount of said fee to be later determined by the principal amount of the bonds finally issued. In addition thereto the city agrees to furnish said counsel at their office in Seattle, Washington, with a complete certified transcript of all proceedings taken in the matter of such local improvment district and the issuance of said bonds and to reimburse said counsel for any and all out-of-pocket expenses which they may incur in the performance of said services.
