

RESOLUTION NO. 397

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington have given notice in the matter of the vacation of a portion of N. E. 112th Street, to the effect that that portion of N. E. 112th Street, 60 feet wide, being a portion of the Aaron Newall Road No. 1148, which lies south of and adjacent to tracts 21 and 21-A of Court Commissioners Plat, Clause No. 175301, recorded in Vol. 1267 of Deeds, Page 1 and 2 under File No. 1966458 of King County Auditor's Records, in Sec. 31, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., and

WHEREAS, the 9th day of January, 1950, was set for hearing on said matter by the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Seattle, Washington, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that the proposed vacation will seriously impair the convenience and valuations of property holders and residents in the area concerned and be detrimental to the best welfare of the community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Council of the City of Kirkland objects to the vacation of said N. E. 112th Street as described above, and as a matter of record request that the Board of County Commissioners maintain and rebuild the portion of the said N. E. 112th Street concerned, to make it safe for use rather than to vacate and close said street.
