WHEREAS, It appears that the basis for the design of the Treatment Plant Enlargement, anticipated too substantial a growth in tributary population and hence in construction costs, new therefore,

BE IT RECOLVED, That the City of Kirkland award the contract for Unit "A", the Rese Point Sewer System, to the low bidder, the Shereline Construction Company of Southle, Washington, in confermance with their bid of May 1,1950, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Consulting Engineer, Harry Sisler, is hereby directed to re-design Unit "B", Enlargement of the Kirkland Treatment Plant, to conform to the lowered standards of design, and to call for contractor's bids to be opened on June 26,1950, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City of Kirkland rejects all bids submitted on May 15,1950, for the construction of Unit "B", the Enlargement of the Kirkland Treatment Plant, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Health Department of the State of Washington.
