

RESOLUTION NO. 402

WHEREAS, by City of Kirkland Ordinance No. 597 the proposition is being put to the voters of the City of Kirkland on October 17, 1950, to determine whether the City of Kirkland shall acquire by purchase or condemnation the facilities of the Puget Sound Power & Light Co., a corporation, and the City of Kirkland thereafter own and operate its own electric power distribution system, and

WHEREAS, it now appears that if said proposition shall pass it will be necessary to immediately institute condemnation proceedings to make effective such decision of the people,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That the Seattle Law Firm of Preston, Thorgrimson & Horowitz be retained as special counsel to work with the City Attorney for the commencement and prosecution of any necessary condemnation proceedings.

Section 2.

That the City Council hereby authorizes the immediate commencement of legal action upon a favorable vote of the people of the City of Kirkland with regard to said proposition.
