

RESOLUTION No. 404

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON,  
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS the Housing Authorities Law of the State of Washington,  
being Remington's Revised Statutes 6889-1 et seq., Supp., as Amended,  
empowers the City Council to declare a need for a Kirkland Housing  
Authority and authorize the appointment of five commissioners for such  
Authority by the Mayor to serve as a governing body;

AND WHEREAS the City Council has considered the needs of Kirkland  
and its area, NOW THEREFORE:

It is hereby resolved and declared that (a) Insanitary or unsafe  
inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the City of Kirkland and its  
area of operations, and (b) There is a shortage of safe or sanitary  
dwelling accommodations in said City and area available to persons of  
low income at rentals they can afford. And that a Kirkland Housing  
Authority is necessary to preserve and improve present facilities  
together with such additional accommodations as may become necessary  
until such time as the need therefor no longer exists.

And, further, the Mayor of the City of Kirkland shall be notified  
of this Resolution and directed to forthwith appoint five persons as  
Commissioners of the Kirkland Housing Authority in accordance with the  
laws of the State of Washington hereinbefore referred to.
