RESOLUTION NO. 406

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the City Council, to-wit, on the 12th day of February, 1951, requesting that the question of the Consolidation of Houghton and Kirkland into one municipal corporation be submitted to the electors of each municipality at a Special Election to be held within 90 days from the filing of the Petition;

AND WHEREAS, the City Clerk has advised the Council that the Petition contains the signatures of sufficient electors to comprise more than one-fifth of the total votes cast at the last general municipal election in the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Elections has advised that such an election could be held on April 10, 1951; now therefore

IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED:

1. That a Special Election to determine whether Houghton and Kirkland shall be consolidated into one municipality shall be called for both of said municipalities on Tuesday, April 10, 1951.

2. That a copy of this Resolution with appropriate letter be transmitted to the Superintendent of Elections and the Town of Houghton.
