RESOLUTION NO. 409

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, existing rates for the opening and closing of graves in the Kirkland Cemetery are not in keeping with present costs

AND WHEREAS the present price for graves is not sufficient to meet the cost of extension and development, now therefore

IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED:

1. That effective immediately there shall be a charge of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) for opening and closing any grave.
2. That effective immediately the price for a single grave in the Kirkland Cemetery shall be FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00).
3. The Cemetery Board is also authorized to empower the Cemetery Caretaker to sell graves and collect therefor at times when the City Clerk's office is not open for business. Any caretaker handling funds for said purpose shall be bonded in the amount of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00).
