1. That effective August 1, 1951, the extension of all sewer mains into presently unimproved areas shall be accomplished on the following basis with cost prorated: A minimum of 75% of the total over-all costs of the extensions shall be borne by affected property owners.

2. That effective August 1, 1951, the extension of all water mains into unimproved areas of the city or any area inside or outside of the city not previously served by mains shall be made on the following basis with cost prorated: A minimum of 75% of the total over-all cost shall be borne by the affected property owners.
