RESOLUTION NO. 410

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, uncertainty has existed concerning the
policy to govern the extension of sewer and water service by the
City of Kirkland, now therefore

IT IS RESOLVED AND DECLARED:

1. That effective August 1, 1951, the extension of all
sewer mains into presently unimproved areas shall be accomplished
on the following basis with cost prorated: A minimum of 75% of
the total over-all costs of the extensions shall be borne by
affected property owners.

2. That effective August 1, 1951, the extension of all
water mains into unimproved areas of the city or any area inside
or outside of the city not previously served by mains shall be
made on the following basis with cost prorated: A minimum of
75% of the total over-all cost shall be borne by the affected
property owners.
