

RESOLUTION NO. 418

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS a Petition has been presented for the vacation of that certain alley described as follows:

A 16 foot alley in Block 99, of Burke & Farrer's Kirkland Business Center as shown in the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, page 11, bounded on the west by the northerly extension of the west line of lot 28, said Block 99 and on its easterly termination by the north line of Cecile Avenue, presently known as First Avenue South, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington.

AND WHEREAS, it appears desirable for the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that said alley be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

1. That a hearing should be had upon the proposed vacation of the following described alley property:

A 16 foot alley in Block 99, of Burke & Farrer's Kirkland Business Center as shown in the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, page 11, bounded on the west by the northerly extension of the west line of Lot 28, said Block 99, and on its easterly termination by the north line of Cecile Avenue, presently known as First Avenue South, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington.

That said hearing should be on May 4, 1953, in the Council Chambers Kirkland City Hall, Kirkland, Washington at 8 o'clock P. M. That notice of this hearing should be posted as required by law.
