

RESOLUTION 424

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington,
as follows:

THAT WHEREAS on June 21, 1954, a special joint meeting was held with the Kirkland City Planning Commission to consider the request for a permit to construct and maintain certain doctors and dentists office buildings within a residential area and the matter having been considered by the Planning Commission, notice having been given of a public hearing, no protest having been received, the Planning Commission having approved the granting of the permit now therefore,

The City Council hereby approves the granting of the permit by the Kirkland Planning Commission for the construction and maintenance of doctors and dentists office buildings on the following described real property situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington:

That portion of Govt. Lot 1, Sec. 8, Twp. 25 N. R. 5 EWM., described as follows: Beginning on the South line of Lake Shre Addition to Kirkland, Washington, to the intersection with the East line of South 2nd Street, as shown in Curtis Addition to Kirkland, produced South; thence South 68 feet to the true point of beginning; thence East 100 feet; thence North 68 feet; thence East 312.5 feet; thence South 201.3 feet; thence West 312.5 ft; thence North 93.30 ft; thence West 100 feet; thence North 40 feet, to the true point of beginning, King County, State of Washington.
